The good news is that our seemingly onerous system actually works. To date we do not know of anyone of our categorised member whose licence applications had been turned down. In fact one phoned me in high spirits with the news that all 96 applications including some cat B weapons were approved. Well done to the Membership Committee who puts in long and mostly unrecognised hours into the early morning!

ADMINISTRATIVE AND MANAGERIAL MATTERS:

2009 Membership Dues:

If there are any members who for some reason has not yet paid their 2009 dues, this serves as a gentle reminder to do so as we have to submit our annual compliancy report to the SAPS CFR, indicating those who no longer is in "Good Standing". For obvious reasons this has a dire impact on your capability to retain your private collector firearm licences. It will be cruel justice to loose your licences having survived the Membership Committee, only because of an oversight to pay your annual subs in time. And please! The SAPS CFR Annual Compliancy Report prevents us from simply correcting late payers, so pay up.

Please remember to indicate very clearly your "initials and surname" along with "2009" on the deposit slip as a deposit reference, ensuring that the bank cashier actually enters it as it is a trifle difficult to smell from whom unidentified payments come. We will also appreciate the courtesy if you would fax or mail us the proof of

payment.

Membership Committee:

All members working on pending applications are requested to submit same A.S.A.P to allow the Mem Com to attend to it well before end March.

FIRE ARM RELICENCING:

31st of MARCH 2009 RE-LICENCING CYCLE applications for those born in the months Oct / Nov / Dec.

You are reminded that if you have not yet done so, to start without any further delay to ensure that we will be able to process it in time to issue you with the required certified categorisation certificates you would need to apply for your licences. It invariably involves serious research to develop a sound Field of Interest and Topic motivation.

Members who have not yet applied to become Categorised Private Collectors are reminded that they must do so before they can apply to have their firearms relicensed. Simply being a member of an accredited association is not enough to keep your firearms. They must prepare a thorough Field of Interest Organogram supported by a written motivation regarding their bona fides as collectors. Once approved a sworn avadavat certifying above as such along with a membership card are issued to the member whom he must include in each firearm licence application to the SAPS. The final deadline for relicensing firearms ends March 2009. Anybody who has not done so stands to lose their firearms. Anybody who has any doubt can contact the Chairman.

For those who has not yet submitted their documents before the deadline, but had to relicence this year, contact the Membership Convenor Robert Nothhaft at roronoma@telkomsa.net

Regardless of above, the licences of those who neglected to relicence will remain valid until the 31st of June 2009. That will allow them time to sell or swap their firearms. Based on Classic Arms Auction prices, the market has firmed on the better quality firearms so all is not doom and gloom.
